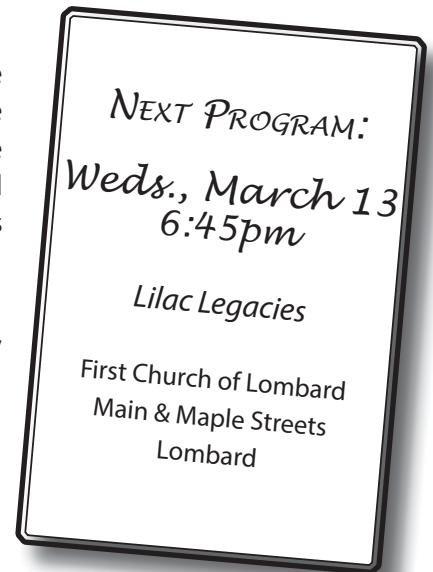


Wednesday, March 13: Lilac Legacies
