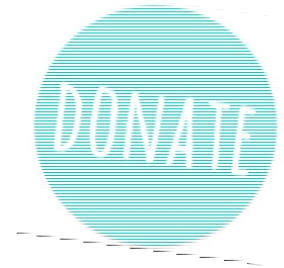
## Mosillo/Dickson Honorary Fund
